

Introduction

Your Philco radio is a superheterodyne receiver. It is designed to operate on 120 volts, either alternating current (a.c.) or direct current (d.c.).

The numbers on the Station Selector scale denote kilocycles; for convenience in reading, the final zeros are omitted. For example, 1000 kilocycles appears as "10" on the scale.

In the event of a national emergency, Civilian Defense broadcasts may be received by tuning your radio to either of the frequencies indicated by the symbol ▲ (640 kc. or 1240 kc.), on the Standard Broadcast (AM) band of your radio.

To Operate Radio

Turn the set on and allow a short time for the tubes to warm up. If no sound is then heard, reverse the power-cord plug in the electric outlet. Rotate the Station Selector to obtain the desired station. Then adjust the Station Selector for the best tone quality and the least background noise. If a slight hum is heard when the volume is turned low, reverse the power-cord plug. **NEVER USE THE STATION SELECTOR TO ADJUST THE VOLUME.**

If the radio should fail to operate, remove the cabinet back and check to see whether the tubes are seated firmly in the proper sockets, as shown by the tube label attached to the cabinet. Replace the cabinet back.

Cleaning The Plastic Cabinet

Use a weak, lukewarm solution of soap and water to clean the plastic cabinet. After cleaning, remove all traces of soap and then wipe with a dry cloth. Never use abrasive soaps, furniture polish, or cleaning solvents, or damage may result to the cabinet finish.

Philco reserves the right to make changes in design or to make additions to or improvements upon this product without incurring any obligation to modify such previously manufactured products.

THIS WARRANTY and the Free Service Guarantee shall not apply to any product which shall have been repaired or altered in any way so as, in our judgment, to affect its performance, nor which has been subject to misuse, abuse, negligence or any other occurrence beyond the control of Philco.
