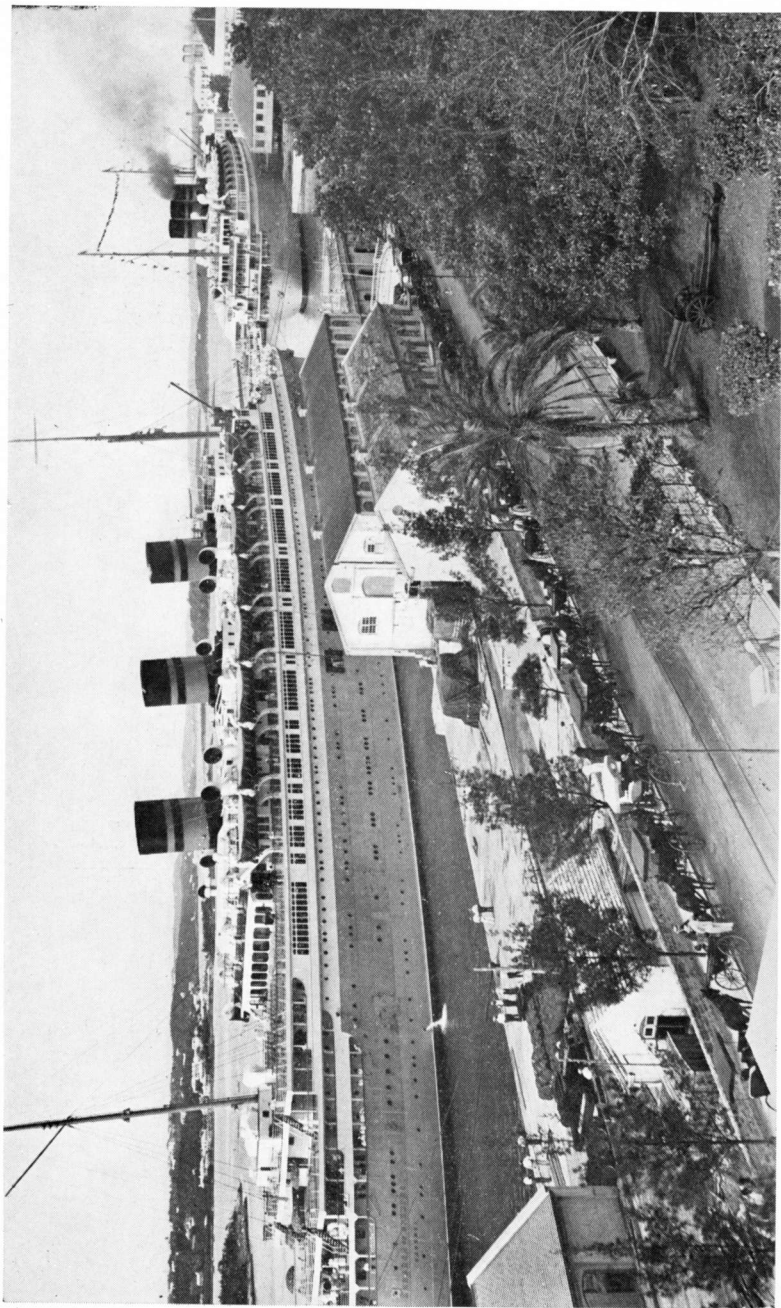



Information for Passengers

Special Notice. Passengers are earnestly requested not to smoke in their staterooms, also to exercise care in disposing of cigars, cigarettes and matches in view of the serious consequences which can arise from carelessness in this respect. Throwing lighted cigarettes, etc., overboard should also be avoided, and passengers are requested to use receptacles provided for the purpose in the various parts of the ship.

Passengers are also earnestly requested to carefully read notices posted in their stateroom giving the location of their emergency station and lifebelts in their stateroom.

Baggage Insurance. All inquiries regarding baggage should be made in New York or Bermuda of the Baggage Master, or on board at the Purser's office. Passengers are recommended to insure their baggage as in the event of loss or damage the Company cannot accept liability beyond the limit specified on the steamer contract ticket. INSURANCE may be obtained from Purser. Rates 5 cents per \$100.00 per day.

Customs. Passengers are cautioned to be particularly careful to inform themselves of the Rules and Regulations of the Custom Authorities and to exercise all care in filling out the Customs Declarations.

Complaints. Passengers having any cause for complaint are requested to communicate particulars to the Staff Captain, Purser or Chief Steward at once and not wait until the end of the voyage.

Pets. Proper and suitable quarters for the care of dogs and other small animals are provided aboard the Company's ships. Therefore they cannot be allowed in staterooms and other places provided for the comfort and convenience of passengers.

Gymnasium and Swimming Pool. The company assumes no responsibility for accidents or injury sustained by passengers while using the Swimming Pool or Gymnasium.

Telephone Ship to Shore, and Wireless

Messages. Apply to the Radio Operator on A deck, midships entrance.

The Surgeon is authorized to make customary charges, subject to the approval of the Commander, for treating any passenger, at their request, for any illness not originating on board the ship. In case of sickness occurring on board no charge will be made and medicine in all cases will be provided free.

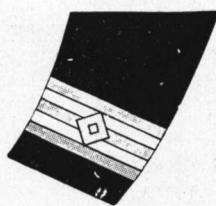

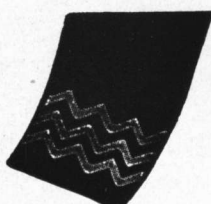

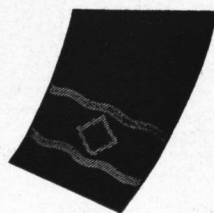
