TO ALL R.M.S. MEMBERS:

First things have to come first - and with the intensive war production effort of our factory, the manpower shortage, the difficulty of obtaining materials, and the extra work of devising substitute materials, - R.M.S. Control Headquarters is now just about swamped.

Because we believe that we can best be of service to you by making intensive efforts to make radio replacement parts available to you, and securing substitute materials where necessary, we are now concentrating most of our efforts in this direction, and will soon have a number of new Catalogue Sheets that will be of great assistance to you. In order to do this, we will have to (for the present at least) publish the Philco Servicoman magazine and the R.M.S. Mailing every other month instead of every month.

This present R.M.S. mailing is the Sept. - Oct. mailing and the next one will be the Nov. - Dec. mailing. The next issue of the Philco Servicoman will be the Oct. - Nov. issue.

Since electrolytic condensers account for a big percentage of your replacement requirements, the attached Catalogue pages (Section VII, 5, 6, 6A and 6B) are an appropriate announcement of your Philco distributors ability to supply all your replacement needs. Those new pages include every Philco Electrolytic Condenser available at the present time. This listing gives you a far greater variety of types than are obtainable from most other parts sources.

Your own experience has shown you the mistake of attempting to use only a very few kinds of condensers to replace the multiplicity of types encountered in service work. Now that fewer servicemen are handling a greater volume of repair work than ever existed before, there is no time for rebuilding or "re-engineering" radio to accommodate parts that do not fit.
