



IF a television station is putting a good picture on the air, a good television receiver must have the basic elements of circuit design to reproduce that picture on the screen. First of all, it must be undistorted and in balance with the station, not stretched out at the center and diminished at the edges. Of course, it must be clear and sharp. But mere sharpness is not enough . . . it must have the middle tones which give detail and reality to the picture. It must have brightness, too. But contrast is even more important. For true brightness is the proper blend of contrast and light for effortless viewing. Finally, it must have the circuit features that keep the picture locked in with the station, synchronized at the proper level and free of interference. ALL THIS makes a good picture ... and all this is yours in Philco for 1950!



TOO BRIGHT. Brightness alone is not a virtue in television. For a picture can be too bright. Excessive brightness fades out the middle tones which give detail to a picture, makes it lose contrast and destroys reality. A picture that is unbalanced in brightness cannot be viewed with comfort over long periods of time.




TOO DIM. A television circuit can be sensitive and yet compromise with picture quality. Improper balance sometimes produces an over-emphasis on the dark values with no clear, brilliant high lights. The result is a dim, muddy, lifeless picture without brightness or contrast.



BALANCED. The Philco picture has the proper balance of clear, brilliant whites, deep, solid blacks and full range of half tones and quarter tones which give it detail, substance and sharp definition. Reflections from lights, room objects or windows that bounce from the glass of the television screen directly to your eyes...that's glare! They tire the eyes, and they reduce picture brightness and contrast.



No Glave A completely new system, developed by Philco engineers, which diverts the reflections to the floor, keeps them from striking your eyes and from entering the picture tube. For the first time, it's television without glare!

Developed by Philco engineers to remove glare and reflections... to make television viewing more comfortable and easier on the eyes.

NOW... only Philco brings you television without glare! The new and exclusive Philco No Glare Optical System, developed in the Philco laboratories, eliminates outside reflections and makes television viewing easier on the eyes than ever before.

Authorities say that television should not be viewed in a darkened room. Because the pupils of the eyes open wide in the dark and concentrating on the light from the picture tires the eyes more quickly. So Philco recommends that there be at least some light in the room when looking at television.

But, in the usual receiver, inside or outside light is reflected from the glass in front of the screen, directly to the eyes. Often reflections from room objects in the glass may mar the picture. To eliminate this major source of television glare, Philco developed an entirely new system of construction which removes the effect of the reflections on the eyes or on the picture. In the *Philco No Glare Optical System*, the picture tube is tilted back so that you look slightly downward at the screen, at the scientifically correct angle to your normal line of vision. But the glass in front of the tube is tilted *forward*. Thus reflections from room lights or windows are entirely gone. Instead of striking the eyes, they are reflected to the floor. And no stray lights hit the picture tube to reduce brightness or contrast.

Finally, the picture mask is covered with a special green lacquer developed during the war for camouflage uses. It is not only restful in color but further reduces reflections. So the Philco 1950 models with the No Glare Optical System are the first receivers ever made that bring you television without glare. It's easy on the eyes . . . and

Packing and Shipping Tests Insure Delivery in Good Condition



Packaging is a highly technical science and again, Philco takes extreme precautions to prevent damage to its receivers in shipment. Packaging engineers study each Philco model and design a packaging plan for that particular receiver which completely protects both its chassis and cabinet from injury in transit.



The sturdiness and packaging of every Philco receiver is tested in this specially designed vibration machine which duplicates all types of rough handling in transit, a bouncing truck on a rough road or a jolting freight car with a flat wheel. Thus, Philco dealers are assured that Philco sets withstand normal shipping hazards.



The action of this specially designed impact machine duplicates dropping a Philco set in its carton from a platform two and a half feet high. It is not only a "drop test" but a "bounce back" test, which is an unusually severe trial of packing efficiency. All these tests were devised with the advice of railroad authorities.
